Edwin "Ed" King, 57, of Bedford, passed away on Tuesday, November 12, 2024 at IU Health

West Hospital in Avon, Indiana.

Ed was born on October 10, 1967 in Belding, Michigan, the son of David Dean and Mary

Catherine (Schutte) King. Ed was a 1987 graduate of Warren High School in Warren, Texas. He

was a US Navy Veteran serving in Desert Shield, Desert Storm, the Southwest Asia Theater,

Operation Sea Angel in Bangladesh, Operation Restore Hope, and in Somalia. While in the

service he received his Associate Degree in Solid state Electronics. He married the love of his life

Ed worked as a Butchers assistant at Tom's meat market in Spurger, Texas as a teenager and

Industrial Electrician at Baxter Pharmaceutical in Bloomington for over fifteen years before

retiring in 2017.
