Ernest McClellan Stevens, age 84 of Bloomington passed away September 14, 2010 at Garden Villa. He was born June 1, 1926 in Belmont, Indiana to Wade A. and Pearl Owens Stevens. Ernest attended Brown County High School until being called during his senior year to serve his country during World War II. He served with honor in the European Theatre in the United States Army.
