She attended Stephens College in Columbia, MO.

Eva worked at her family's Burns Wholesale Grocery during George's WWII service. After managing two of the Burns' fourteen central Indiana grocery stores Eva and George opened and operated Godsey Super Market at 17th and College Avenue in Bloomington, IN for 20 years until their moved to McGregor, MN in 1964.

While living in Minnesota, she enjoyed watching, feeding and learning about the winter birds.

Eva moved back to Bloomington, IN after George's passing in 1970.

Her favorite pastime was studying her Bible. She was an extraordinary quilter and made multiple quilts for each child and grandchild. She also enjoyed reading, watching I.U. basketball and playing Canasta with her friends. For many years she was a Pink Lady at Bloomington Hospital.

At an early age, Eva was baptized into Christ. Her Christian walk began at the Lincoln Street Church of Christ, followed by the Indiana Avenue congregation. While in Minnesota, Eva, George, and son Jim were faithful members of a small congregation in Tamarack, MN. After returning to Indiana, the Ellettsville

Church of Christ was her church home.

Eva was a beautiful woman with a ready smile and winsome personality and her family and friends will miss her wonderful spirit.
