



Fred L. Wesemann

March 12, 1931 - January 1, 1753

Fred L. Wesemann, 82, of Bloomington passed away Tuesday morning, Sept. 17, 2013 at his residence with his loving family at his side. He was born in Bloomington on March 12, 1931 the son of Frederick A. Wesemann and Alma (Dillon) Wesemann-Rowe. He was a graduate of French Lick High School and a Navy veteran of the Korean War.

Fred was a self-employed owner and operator of Wesemann Electric, Heating and Air Conditioning for over 53 years in the Bloomington area. He was a longtime member of the West Second St. Church of Christ where he previously served as Deacon, Elder and Bible Study leader, served on the Monroe County Fair Board for over 30 years and was a 4-H Leader of the Hurricane Hoosiers 4-H Club for 22 years. He was also a member of the Burton Woolery Post #18 of the American Legion in Bloomington.

He is survived by his wife, Beverly (Haley) Wesemann, one daughter and son-in-law, Tara and Mike Stogsdill of Springville, two sons

and a daughter-in-law, Tad Wesemann and Tod and Lisa Wesemann, all of Bloomington, six grandchildren; Kyla Stogsdill, Ty (Ashley) Stogsdill, Trent (Megan) Stogsdill, Troy (Abigail) Stogsdill, Levi Wesemann and Sarah Wesemann, seven great grandchildren; Lucas Stogsdill, Jalee Stogsdill, Colton Stogsdill, Maelin Stogsdill, Trevor, Stogsdill, Callie Stogsdill and Reagan Stogsdill.
