Fred James Stewart, 82, of Bloomington passed away Wednesday, April 4, 2018 at the IU Health Bloomington Hospital. Fred was born on October 30, 1935, he was the son of the late Herman and Ruth (Bromagem) Stewart of Winchester, Indiana.

He graduated from Winchester High School and started his career as an apprentice Engineer with the Overmyer Mould Company.
