February 10, 1924 - September 20, 2009

Frederick "Blaine" Deckard, of Bloomington passed away Sunday, September 20, 2009 at Indiana University Hospital after a long illness. He was 85 years old.

Born February 10, 1924 in Monroe County he was the son of Fred and Verna (Anderson) Deckard. He was a graduate of Smithville High School. Blaine served in the US Army Air Force during WWII and was stationed in India. He retired from the US Postal Service where he was a letter carrier for 40 years. He enjoyed woodworking and model building. His memberships include the Sons of the American Revolution, National Association of Retired Federal Employees and the National Letter Carriers Association #828. He was a member of the Northside Christian Church and attended the Woodhaven Christian Church.

Blaine is survived by his wife of 65 years, Wanda (Frye) Deckard of Bloomington; a daughter Beverly K.
