February 21, 1924 - August 6, 2025

Frieda Mavis Hoffman, 101, of Bloomington, passed away August 6, 2025, after a long life that touched so many others. At the Bloom Assisted Living facility where she spent her two years, she was referred to, always with a smile, as “Miss Frieda” and “The Boss Lady”.

She was born on the family farm in Royal Center, Indiana on February 21, 1924, to John Harvey and Mary Lavina (Vernon) Harvey. Frieda met George Hoffman in high school. They married the July following graduation in 1942. They were married 58 years and moved to Bloomington in 1964.
