Gerald L. Rogers, 85, of Bloomington, passed away on Friday, May 11, 2018 at I.U. Health Bloomington Hospice House. He was born on December 27, 1932 in Bloomington, the son of the late Lloyd and Colleen (Grey) Rogers.

Gerald joined the United States Army on March 16, 1953, where he went on to serve in the Korean War. He was honorably discharged in 1955. He later went on to work for R.C.A. as a troubleshooter before his retirement following 35 years of service.
