Glenn Robert "Smitty" Smith, age 84 of Bloomington passed away at his residence Friday morning December 20, 2013. He was born December 3, 1929 in Kentucky to Robert and Dorothy Cox Smith. Smitty spent his professional career as a heavy equipment operator for various construction and excavation firms in and around Bloomington.
