Gordon Kirk, 10/26/21. Gordon Kirk, 72, passed away in his home, surrounded by family, on June 6, 2022.

Born in Sullivan, IN on June 10, 1949, he was the son of Gilbert & Adah (Brooks) Kirk.

Gordon graduated from Switz City Central High School in 1967. He lettered in track and cross country. Gordon loved to run, setting a school record for running the 1600m in 4:32.

He was a member of Lincoln Christian Church. A masterful gardener, he ate radishes right out of the garden, and made the best fried green tomatoes. He was a member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles, The American Legion, and AMVETS.

He worked in maintenance at Meadowood until retirement. He knew how to fix most anything, and was the go-to guy for many.

Gordon is a veteran of the Vietnam War, and served honorably (1967-1970) as a Signal Corps Specialist in the US Army.

Gordon would readily admit to a life lived with mistakes and regrets. He was committed to finishing life at his best. He worked methodically on his extensive to-do list, checking everything off while he had time. He was determined to mend every fence, appreciate each day, and say every last “thank you,” “I’m sorry,” and “I love you.”

His phone was full of pictures of friends, family, pets, and sunrises. Gordon

was a gift to all who knew him, and became a shining example of how to end life with grace and love.

Gordon is survived by his wife of 43 years, Judy (Hawkins) Kirk; his loving children Jessica (Heath) Padgett, Aprell Kirk, Samantha (Charley) Kirk; four grandchildren, Heather, Shayna, Emory, Auden; four great grandchildren; brothers, Bill Kirk, Errol Kirk; sisters Shelia (Lloyd) Milam, Donna (Gary) Burnett, Ellen Kirk, Deborah Dicus; several nieces and nephews.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Gilbert and Adah Kirk, brother Jeff Kirk, sister-in-law Pam Kirk.
