Gregory Lee Beyers, age 57 of Ellettsville, passed away at his residence early Sunday morning, January 17, 2016. He was born in Blomington on January 16, 1959 to Donald Lee Beyers and Janet L. Chestnut Beyers.

Greg attended Bloomington High School North and spent his entire professional career in the roofing industry as owner of Beyers Roofing. 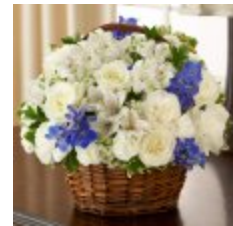
