



Gregory Leon "Greg" Bock

November 25, 1959 - November 20, 2018

Gregory Leon Bock, 58, of Bloomington IN passed away on November 20, 2018 after a long illness. Greg was born in Bloomington Indiana, graduated from Bloomington High School North in 1977; from Indiana University with a BS in Computer Science in 1983; from Johns Hopkins University with an MS in Computer Science in 1987; In his spare time, he earned his Doctorate in Religious Studies and one in Data Management from Johns Hopkins University.

After graduating from IU in 1983, Greg accepted a position with the National Security Agency, in Baltimore, MD as a Computer Engineer. In 1995 he moved to Denver CO and worked for Lockheed Martin as a Systems Engineer at Buckley Airforce Base in Aurora, CO. In 1997 Greg accepted a position with National Jewish Hospital in Denver, CO as their Deputy, Chief Technical Officer and in 2010 became the Chief Information Officer with Mental Health Partners, Boulder, CO. Greg returned "home" to Bloomington in June 2018. Greg was an avid Ham Radio Operator and was proud to have contacted and received a QSL card from King Hussein of Jordan as a member of the IU HAM Radio Club. Greg was also an accomplished musician with his home recording studio. He sound engineered a gospel album with his church choir. He was the acting manager of a rock band that played in Colorado. He would work all day and do music gigs at night often returning home at 3am just to return to work early. In addition, Greg loved hiking and camping in Rocky Mountain National Park with his son Josh. Greg was highly intelligent and had

a lot of energy.

Greg sang in the choir at both Faith Presbyterian Church [Aurora, CO] and Cornerstone Community Church [Denver, CO]. He played Bass guitar on the worship team at Greenwood Community Church {Greenwood Village, CO} He most recently attended Flatirons Community Church in Lafayette, CO.

He is survived by his mother, Margaret Bock, of Bloomington, IN, his son, Joshua David Bock of Denver, CO; fiancée Debbie Peterson, of Lafayette, CO; and his youngest brother Richard Bock, of Bordon, IN. Greg is also survived by his nieces and nephews Naomi, James, Riley and Kelsey Bock. Greg was preceded in death by his father Marion L. Bock and a brother Karl A. Bock and his Grandparents.

Greg thought the world of his family.

Greg's 59th Birthday would have been on November 25th, the day of the visitation.

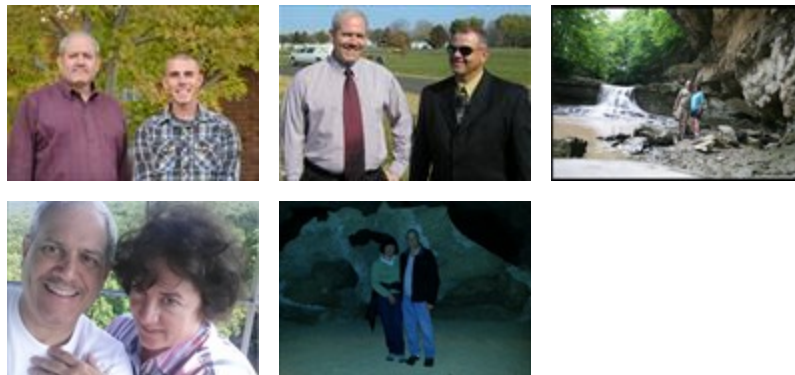
