Which is where some of my fondest memories and funny stories with him take place. (On my days off I would go to goodwill. One day I decided to go look around and without knowing I walk in the doors and head back towards the collectibles and randoms little did I know there he stood. After catching up and talking a minute I headed out to the other goodwill on the other side of town well needless to say after about an hour looking, I go to leave and standing by the carts, he stood, I walked up to him and just laugh and say, "what are the chances I would see you again". This has also happened on more than one occasion and memories I will never forget. Many of us have similar and fond memories with him that we could tell for days.
