



## Harry "Steve" Cummings

Harry "Steve" Cummings 63 of Bloomington passed away Monday September 18, 2017 at home surrounded by his family.

He was born December 4, 1954 to Harry E. and Sharon A. (Baker) Cummings in Linton, IN.

Steve comes from a family of quarry workers and his sons have continued this family tradition.

Steve was in the limestone industry for nearly 40 years. He was most proud of the 34 years he worked at Independent Limestone, where he started working on the bottom line and worked his way to General Manager.

As the general manager, he was honored to have been a part of the quarrying of the stone that was used to build the National Cathedral and rebuild the Pentagon.

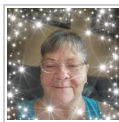
Yep, you guessed it, Deb would talk about all the fun times her and Steve would have with each child or Grandchild.
