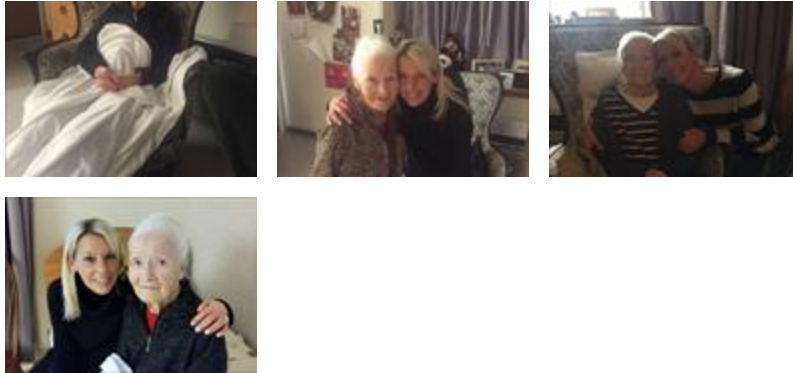
“ *Dear Aunt Helen,
