On Sunday night, August 25, 2019, at 11:30 p.m., Helen Beryl Koontz, a wonderful lady, passed from this life to her heavenly reward. She was 78 years of age. She was a brave woman who was ready for her years of battling multiple illnesses to be over.

Helen was born in Harrodsburg, Indiana on September 29, 1940. Her parents were Opal and Marian Flinn, both deceased. She was born into a family of 12 children, Norma Grogen, Bonnie Parker, Kenny Flinn (Deceased), Paul Flinn (Deceased), Anna Long, Ralph Flinn (Deceased) Bobby Flinn (Deceased), Billy Flinn, and Phyllis White.
