Hilda Flebotte was born in Ludlow, Massachusetts and raised by her loving parents, Domingos and Amelia Alves who immigrated to the United States from Portugal in the early 1900's. She enjoyed the support, care, and protection from her parents and her four older brothers: Alec, Manny, "Smiles", and David.

Upon graduation from Ludlow High School, Ludlow Massachusetts, Hilda chose a career in nursing and completed her training as a Registered Nurse at the Springfield Hospital, now known as the Bay State Medical Center. This was a true vocation for her and in the course of her long career, she was valued as a nurse in many different areas of service and instilled an attitude of caring for others in her children.
