Hugh Francis "Tim" Hines, 91, died October 20, 2022 in Bloomington, Indiana. He was preceded in death by his wife of 59 years, Mary Ann, his daughter Martha Lee, his brothers Thomas and Norman, and his parents William and Irma Hines.

Born in Burlington, Iowa, he married his high school sweetheart, Mary Ann Knoll. He served in the National Guard and US Navy. At the University of Iowa, he ran track and earned a degree in journalism. He spent his career managing non-profits in Iowa, Evansville (Chamber of Commerce), and Indianapolis, (Builders Assoc. of Greater Indianapolis) until his retirement in Bloomington.

Tim and Mary Ann were avid supporters of programs for people with disabilities. Their third of five children had Down's Syndrome and her presence inspired the family to be active in programs and education for people with special needs. Tim was recognized for his work in these programs from 1961-2010 throughout Southern IN including Stonebelt.

Tim is survived by his loving family and team, his son Kevin (Dee), and daughters, Rebecca Philippsen (Greg), Sarah Smith (David), and Jennifer Pierce (John), 16 grandchildren and 37 great grandchildren.
