Hyla McKee Hunter Cecil passed away Saturday, August 4th, 2018, from complications of diabetes at the age of 85. Born and raised in Nelson County Kentucky, Hyla was the younger daughter of Eugene Hunter and Winifred (Prather) Parrot.
