Jack Eugene Conway Fike, 91, of Bloomington, Indiana passed away on May 5, 2019 at Richland-Bean Blossom Health in Bloomington.

Jack was born on January 29, 1928 in Bloomington, Illinois to the late E. Clyde Fike and Jean (Stephens) Fike. He graduated from University High School in 1946 and went on to attend Indiana University. Jack worked as a dental lab tech, a hobby shop owner, and a body shop estimator throughout his life. Jack had a full life of building and flying thousands of model aircraft and R/C aircraft and was a member of the American Modelers Association.
