James Edward Scott, age 86 of Bloomington passed away Wednesday morning September 18, 2013, at Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born in Monroe County on January 31, 1927 to William W. and Mary Puckett Scott.

James was very proud of his military service in the United States Navy during World War II. He served in the Asiatic Pacific Theatre aboard the USS Monterey receiving the Asiatic Pacific Area Campaign Medal (2 Stars) and the Philippine Liberation Ribbon.

He went on to spend his professional career as a chef with Groves Restaurant for over 32 years and as a security guard with CFC Properties at Fountain Square for nearly 25 years before retiring at the age of 85.

James was extremely fond of cooking, baking pies, his cat fish fishing and NASCAR.
