“ A Eulogy for James Anthony Presutti
May 19, 2017

“Gentle giant,” may be a bit overused, but Jim Presutti always made its meaning fresh. This big, wonderful man – whose always-calm and pleasant voice made you want to listen – was a joy to know. And, for sure, hundreds of clients -- for whom Jim installed satellite-TV dishes over the years -- were impressed by that voice, his handsomeness and quiet efficiency. And, perhaps most of all, they remember his kind and courteous demeanor.

But Jim was much more than that. He was a model husband and father, devoted to Ruth – his wife and business partner – and son Jacob, both of whom adored him. Their loss is monumental and solitary. Their grief, however, is shared by many of us. That grief will endure, but the rich memories of him help to make it bearable.

“Death be Not Proud,” the title of an old, but enduring, radio documentary, seems so appropriate now as we mourn the loss of James Anthony Presutti. His memory, though, will always make us proud.
