



## Janine Reagan

August 29, 1956 - June 16, 2025

Janine Reagan née Ford, 68, of Bloomington, Indiana passed away June 16, 2025, after living with Alzheimer's disease for over thirteen years.

Born August 29, 1956 in Hudson, Michigan, she was the daughter of Richard and Ruth Ford, née Sutter. Janine was a 1974 graduate of Bloomington High School North, and attended Indiana University, where she met her husband Michael Reagan during their freshman year. They were married for 37 years until his untimely death from cancer in 2016.

Janine's favorite role was as mother to their children, Kathleen and David. She was able to stay at home with them through much of their childhood, and became the favorite classroom mom and school field trip supervisor. Janine also worked as a secretary and office assistant at Public Health Nursing, Fairview United Methodist Church, and several departments at Indiana University.

Janine was a member of Clear Creek Christian Church and Ellettsville Christian Church for several years and served as a Sunday School teacher, youth group leader, and nursery supervisor. She was a member of Tri Kappa sorority and volunteered in their community service. Through her husband Mike, a teacher and coach at RBBCSC, she often volunteered for the local schools, working the concession stand or selling tickets at sporting events.

Janine is survived by her daughter Kathleen Reagan, son David and daughter-in-law Erin Reagan, grandchildren Jonas and Eleanor, mother Ruth Sager, brother Doug Ford, sister Kristin Wiedenhoeft, and several nieces and nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband Michael, her father Richard, and her stepfather Ray Sager.
