Jeannie Day Denning, 77, of Bloomington, Indiana passed away on Saturday, October 31, 2020 at IU Health Hospice House in Bloomington, Indiana. She was born on December 12, 1942 in Goldsboro, North Carolina the daughter of Edward Cline Denning Jr. and Marian (McDowell) Denning. She attended Goldsboro High School in Goldsboro, N.C., the University of North Carolina, and Eastman Kodak Photography courses. Jeannie married the love of her life Marcia Ann Kazmierzak on November 29, 2014 in Bloomington, Indiana. They were together 38 years. She taught photography at Bradford Woods in Martinsville and in her own workshop "Through the Eyes of Women." She also worked for T.I.S. Publishing and PDK International in Bloomington for many years. She was a member of Trinity Episcopal Church. Jeannie was a true artist and enjoyed photography, drawing, painting, and wood engraving. She was known for the clocks and shelf art she created of Indiana and North Carolina landmarks. She loved music. She played the guitar with the depth of her soul and great musical ability. She also played banjo and ukulele. She loved dancing and taught two-stepping. She was an avid student of history and enjoyed lively discussions of ideas with others. She loved gardening, always sharing her fruits with neighbors, and was an excellent cook. She loved bird watching, learning about, and observing nature, especially her chipmunks. She loved the Atlantic Ocean, Lake Michigan, and Lake Monroe. She never met a stranger, always stopping to speak with whomever she met. She had a wonderful sense of humor and was a great

storyteller. She was a good listener and a special friend. She will be deeply missed. Those beautiful blue eyes! Ever seeking, ever learning, ever watching, ever seeing, ever caring. Soar with the eagles my friend!

Jeannie is survived by her wife, Marcia Ann Kazmierzak of Bloomington; a sister, Cathy (Harold) Denning Hollingworth of Goldsboro, N.C.; and one niece, and one nephew, a great niece, several great nephews and one great, great nephew. 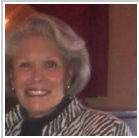

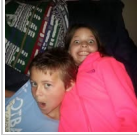
