Jennings M. Polley, 92, of Bloomington, Indiana passed away on July 24, 2018 at IU Hospice House surrounded by his loving family. Jennings was born on January 3, 1926 in Bloomington, Indiana to the late Theodore and Hazel (Sylvester) Polley.

He attended Bloomington High School and graduated in 1943. He went on to earn a Bachelor's Degree in Business from Indiana University in 1950.

Jennings married the love of his life Patricia Fields in August of 1946, they shared 71 wonderful years together. Jennings worked at Sarkes Tarzian as a Production Manager for over 20 years. He served in the Army during WWII and went to work at Crane, in Public Works Weapons Support Division until retirement. Jennings was a 2-time state wrestling champion and is honored in the Indiana Wrestling Hall of Fame. He was a member of the Monroe County Athletic Hall of Fame as well as the Bloomington Panthers State Champion Wrestling Club. Jennings was active in his community as well as his church. He was a member of Gideons International and a 79-year member of Clear Creek Christian Church. Jennings was a beloved husband, father, and grandfather. He will be deeply missed.
