Jerry Shields, 80 of Bloomington, passed away Tuesday, November 24, 2020, at IU Health Bloomington Hospital, surrounded by family.

He was born on September 19, 1940, in Monroe County, Indiana, the son of Earl Emerson and Ida Mae (Hupp) Shields. He attended Smithville High School.

Jerry married the love of his life, Sonja (Crouch) Shields, on April 17, 1958, in Bloomington, Indiana. They were married for 62 years. Jerry was the owner and operator of Shields Construction for more than 50 years, serving Monroe and surrounding counties. His amazing work includes The Fields, The Woodlands, Henderson Crossing and renovations of downtown Bloomington as well as custom homes.

He loved working on sprint cars, and he had been a sprint car owner since 1969. He won several championships, including SCRA, USAC, IMCA and Allstars. He was a member of HARF Hall of Fame and he received the HARF Mechanic of the Year award.

He loved his grandchildren and would do anything for them. He also enjoyed working and taking care of the family farm.
