Jody Ann Miller completed her earthly journey on June 25th, 2023. Jody was born November 28th, 1952, the second child of Tom J Miller and Ruth Boehler Miller.

Jody was always fond of horses and was an accomplished rider. She excelled in school and enjoyed cheerleading in support of the University High School Univees. In the Spring of her Junior year, she was badly injured in an auto accident returning from a date in April of 1969. Despite the care of her doctors and the love and support of her parents, she was left with damage that prevented her from living the promise of her life.

Even though she spent the balance of her life in a nursing home, cognizant of her condition and surroundings, she never lost her sense of humor and gratitude. Though nonverbal, her facial gesture and hand signs made it clear to all what she was thinking and feeling. Jody would beam with excitement sitting atop a horse in the PALS program. Her mother and father would assist with her physical therapy to insure she could enjoy this activity as long as possible.

The care that Jody received from her parents and the professionals at Garden Villa nursing home [now Majestic Care of Bloomington] raised the quality of her life and allowed her to live fifty-four years beyond that Saturday night in

April so many years ago. In place of a funeral, there will be a brief private graveside service July 11th.

The family is grateful for all those who befriended Jody and showed their love by reading to her, sharing their pets and included her in special events like going to the Kentucky Derby.

Jody will be buried next to her parents in Valhalla Memory Gardens in Bloomington.

Jody is survived by her brother Thomas Miller of Marathon, Florida.

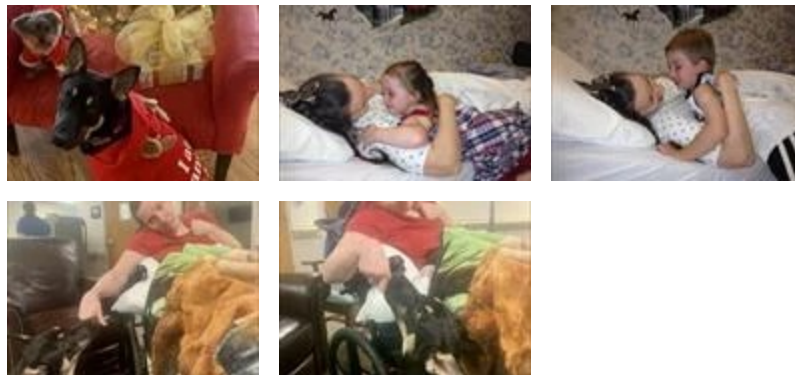
