John Aaron Owen, age 42 of Bloomington departed his earthy home while abroad in Scotland (UK) on June 15th as a result of a fatal car accident.

He was born July 24, 1975 in Bloomington, Indiana to John H. Owen and Sandra (Daniels) Owen.

John also known as, Aaron, by family and friends, was a 1993 graduate of Owen Valley High School and went on to receive his Bachelors of Science degree from Thomas Edison State University. John worked at Naval Surface Warfare Center, Crane Division, where he was employed since 2010. John was a valuable member of the Submarine Battery Team. Prior to working at NSWC Crane John proudly served in the United States Navy for over 13 years. John served aboard the USS Rhode Island (SSBN 740) for over 7 and half years and aboard the USS Annapolis (SSN 760) for 18 months. In between submarine assignments John worked on shore at the Nuclear Prototype Command in upstate NY. Aaron and his wife Candy are members of Smithville Christian Church. He thoroughly enjoyed being outdoors, whether cutting wood, working in his garden, sitting by the fire or playing in the pool with his family. He truly will be remembered for his kind soul and his caring and selfless nature.

John leaves behind his loving wife of nearly 14 years, Candy (Long) Owen,

children Trista Long, Rebecca Owen, and Noah Owen, all of Bloomington. His father John H. Owen survives as well as his mother Sandra (Jeff) Wallace, all of Spencer. His siblings Jacob (Lindsey Ellis) Owen of Cloverdale, Alexandra (Jake) Maire of Ellettsville, Chelsey (Tyler) Curl of Worthington; and Lisa (Ken) Eldrige of Spencer; nieces and nephews Jordan Eldrige, Megan Eldrige, Addison Ellis, Victoria Owen, Ian Owen and Grant Curl also survive. 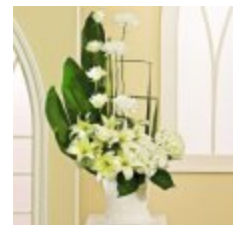

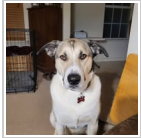
