John Victor Welsh was a loving father, grandfather, brother, and son. He left this world suddenly on January 3, 2022 at his home in Bloomington, at age 59.

An Indy native, John graduated from Bishop Chatard High School in 1980. After his graduation John served in the U.S. Marine Corps as a radio operator and achieved a ranking of Corporal before being honorably discharged in 1984. Once returning to Indiana, John moved to Bloomington to obtain his Bachelor of Arts in Criminal Justice and Psychology from Indiana University. He worked several years as a child protection worker and helped adults with special needs before joining the USPS in 1998, where he worked as a mail carrier for 23 years.

John was an avid lover of music, art, and horticulture. He loved to use his imagination to create art for his family and even created a detailed miniature toy train diorama for his grandchildren.

John is survived by his children Victoria (Zachary) Young of Bloomington, Patrick (Hayley) Welsh of Houston, TX and Andrew Welsh of Bloomington, mother Carolyn Welsh of Indianapolis, sisters Leona Borinstein of Indianapolis and Patricia Rea of Tampa, FL, brothers Joseph and Robert Welsh both of Indianapolis, grandchildren Benton, Kennedy and Eleanor, and several nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by his father Leo Welsh.
