Joseph Stringfellow, age 36, passed away Sunday November 8, 2020. He was born and raised in Bloomington, Indiana. He attended Harmony School, Clear Creek Elementary, Jackson Creek Middle School and South High School. He attended Indiana University one year, then completed his degree at Full Sail University in Florida.

From Florida, he moved to Austin, TX where he lived and worked for 8 years. From Austin, he moved to Kalispell, Montana in 2017 where he stayed for one year. In 2018, he moved back to Indiana where he remained until his death.
