Joyce Ann Teague, 69, of Bloomington, passed away Wednesday, August 9, 2017 at IU Health Bloomington Hospice House. She was born on November 17, 1947 in Terre Haute, Indiana.

Joyce graduated from Bloomington High School in 1965 and attended Indiana University. Her working career included Kroger's and Dr. Lafollette and Dr. McClary's office. She was a school bus driver for Monroe County for 14 years before retiring from MCCSS as a secretary in the administration department. She had been a Brownie Leader, Girl Scout Leader, and Bethel Guardian of the Job's Daughters. Joyce was a homemaker who took great pride in her home and her flowers. Her greatest treasures were her children and grandchildren. Joyce was a member of St. Paul's United Methodist Church.

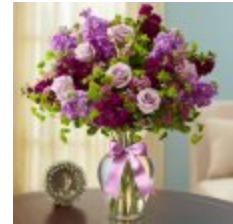

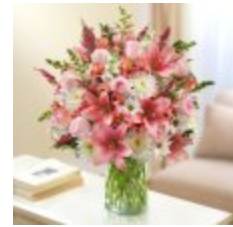
