Juanita Lucille Hannum, age 101 of Bloomington passed away Friday evening December 5, 2014 at Garden Villa Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. She was born August 25, 1913 in Calvertville, Indiana to Charles Wilson and Ida Groomer Wilson.
