Judith K. "Judy" Baker, 75, Bloomington died on Thursday, December 10, 2009 in Columbus, Indiana. She was born on August 8, 1934 in Monroe County the daughter of Raymond and Wilma (Stanger) Bunger. In 1952 she graduated from Bloomington High School and married Kenneth Perry. In 1971 she married Wesley H. Baker, with whom she also owned and operated Calico-N-Wood Craft Shop near Unionville where she loved to paint, teach crafts and show others how to create beautiful pieces of art.
