Justin Wayne Kirby, 26, of Bloomington died tragically on Saturday, September 26th at his residence. Justin was born in Monroe County on April 1, 1989; he was the son of Jack B. and Sandra K. (Quillen) Kirby. He graduated from Bloomington High School South in 2007 and was a current student at Ivy Tech in Bloomington.

Justin enjoyed being outdoors and riding his horse. He truly loved being with his children and was a stay at home dad. His children adored their father and will miss him dearly. He knew no stranger and would lend a hand to anyone who needed it. He faced many obstacles in life by being diagnosed at a young age with cones dystrophy. As Justin aged his eye condition worsened to cone/rod dystrophy which limited his eye sight to being only able to see within inches of his face. Even with failing eye sight that would eventually lead to full blindness he never gave up in life and continued to live his life as normal as possible. Justin continued to have faith that advances in science would one day restore his eye sight.

Justin is survived by his three loving children Carter Farris, Gunner Kirby and Grace Kirby of

Bloomington; parents Jack and Sandra Kirby of Springville; sister and brother-in-law Celeste and Jeromy Pearson of Springville; niece Ariele Flynn and maternal grandmother Martha Quillen of Houston, TX; along with numerous aunts, uncles and cousins.

He was preceded in death by his maternal grandfather Frank Quillen and his paternal grandparents Viola and William Edward Kirby.

Funeral services will be held 1pm Thursday, October 1, 2015 at Allen Funeral Home; 4155 S. Old State Road 37, with Pastor David Mullens officiating. Burial will follow in Clear Creek Cemetery. The family will receive friends from 4-8pm Wednesday and 12-1pm Thursday at Allen Funeral Home.
