Kathleen Janice Thompson (née Buell), born June 5, 1939, in Cleveland, Ohio, to Alfred and Margaret Buell, was the second child and first daughter in her family. She graduated from Vermilion High School in 1958 and married the love of her life, George Thompson, on June 28, 1958. Together, they built a beautiful life centered on faith, family, and service.

Her passions were many: music of all kinds, spinning and weaving, Bible study, and exploring nature. She loved birdwatching, often with binoculars and bird book in hand, and spent countless hours collecting treasures in the woods near her home.
