Kelly Michele Doane Emerick, age 48, of Bloomington passed away early Monday morning July 22, 2013 at her residence. She was born in Bloomington on June 29, 1965 to John and Nancy Hosteter Doane.

Kelly was a 1983 graduate of Eastern Greene High School where she was President of the National Honor Society. She then went on to Indiana University where she was a member of the Sigma Kappa social sorority, graduating in 1988.

Kelly devoted her professional career to Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital, working there for 23 years. She first started as an EMTB, then as a paramedic before becoming a field supervisor for the paramedics for the last 10 years.

Kelly's interests were broad and varied. She loved being outdoors, gardening, and swimming. She especially prided herself on her morel mushroom hunting skills. Kelly was an avid Indiana University sports fans, often working at various events in order to cheer them on. She had a deep appreciation of music, and an unending love of animals.

Kelly leaves behind her daughter Brigit Marguerite Emerick of Bloomington; mother Nancy Hosteter Doane of Solsberry, and brother Greg D. Doane, also of Solsberry. She is also survived by numerous aunts, uncles and cousins.

A funeral service to celebrate Kelly's life will be held Saturday, July 27, 2013, at 11:00AM at Allen Funeral Home 4155 South Old Highway 37. She will be buried near her father, John, in the Greene County Chapel Cemetery, who preceded her in death in 2009. Visitation will be held Friday July 26, 2013 from 2:00PM until 8:00PM also at Allen Funeral Home.
