August 28, 1943 - November 12, 2012

Kenneth Wayne Crouch age 69 of Bloomington passed away Monday morning November 12, 2012 at Indiana University Health Bloomington Hospital. He was born in Monroe County to Thomas and Pearl Gilliland Crouch on August 28, 1943.
