Kerrick Charles Casey Ryan of Bloomington passed away early Tuesday morning April 13, 2010 at the Bloomington Hospital. He was 56 years old. Casey was born on August 4, 1953 in Manketo, Minnesota to Dr. John W. and Dora Patricia Goodday Ryan. Casey attended Deerfield Academy in Deerfield, Massachusetts for 2 years before graduating from Bloomington High School. He received his Bachelor's Degree from Arizona State University and was awarded his Masters Degree from Indiana University. Casey spent his professional career in the compliance division of Anthem-Blue Cross/Blue Shield Insurance Company. He was a lover of music and an avid fan of athletics, especially the Indianapolis Colts and Indiana University. Casey leaves behind his parents, Dr. John W. Ryan and Patricia Goodday Ryan of Bloomington; a sister Kathleen Elynn Ryan-Acker of Bloomington; a brother Kevin D. Ryan and wife Shirley of South Lyon, Michigan; nephews Ryan Acker and Kyle Ryan; nieces Monica Acker-Futrell and husband Adam, Kristin Ryan and Kelly Ryan.
