Kevin A. Routt, 35, of Bloomington, passed away Thursday, April 18, 2013. He was born on June 21, 1977 in Bloomington, IN; he was the son of Gregory Routt and Diana (Goodman) Routt McGlocklin. Kevin graduated from Bloomington North High School class of 1995. He served in the United States Marine Corp. Kevin had worked at the Monroe County Jail as a corrections officer and most recently at IU Health Bloomington Hospital as security. He enjoyed health and fitness and was working on becoming a certified trainer. Kevin also helped at the Danny Smith Park as a ball coach. Kevin is survived by his mother Diana and Robert McGlocklin; one son Andrew Routt; one brother Bradley Routt; step sister Cathy Arvin; step brother Tony McGlocklin; aunts and uncles Gary and Barbara Edwards, Bill and Nancy Parks, Rick Routt, Gordon and Janice Southern, Bill and Melissa Goodman and Randy Goodman; and several cousins, nieces and nephews.
