Larry Michael Thrasher, 75, of Bloomington, passed away Friday, December 11, 2020 at Bloomington Nursing and Rehab Center. Larry was born on July 23, 1945 in Bloomington to Harry W. Thrasher and Juanita M. (Hamm) Thrasher.

Larry grew up at Cascades Golf Course, where he caddied and worked on maintenance in his youth. He joined the Army in 1963 and was at Fort Knox, Kentucky. Then he served in the National Guard until 1969.
