Layne Robert Gerber-Rogers, age 19, passed away, surrounded by family, at IU Health Bloomington Hospital on January 21, 2024. Born on July 28, 2004 to Scott Aaron Rogers and Jennifer Lynn Gerber, Layne was a student at Ivy Tech Community College and a graduate of Bloomington High School South. The multi-age class at Templeton Elementary School was an especially fond stop on his educational journey.

Survivors include his parents, non-biological parents (Allison Nicole Knight and Jason Edward McKinnley Anderson), sister (Dorothy Joan Fisher), brother (Rylan Edward Anderson), a great-grandma, grandparents, aunts and uncles, cousins, and many pets.

Layne had special relationships with all his animals, but was renowned for abilities as a “cat whisperer”. His deepest passion was video gaming - he had a controller in his hands since he was big enough to hold one - he created his own characters and worlds, studying for a career in game design.
