Lesa Kay Woodward, 69, of Bloomington, passed away on Sunday, July 13, 2025, at IU Health Bloomington Health.

She was born on December 3, 1955, in Linton to William Jack and Martha Ann (Fischer) Woodward; they preceded her in death.

Lesa graduated from Woodward Academy in Atlanta, Georgia in 1975 and she obtained her Bachelor of Science degree in 1979 at William Wood University in Fulton, Missouri. She went on to work as a teacher for dyslexic students at De Paul Schools in Louisville, Kentucky, Jacksonville, Florida, and Bloomington, Indiana from 1979 until 1990. She later worked in pharmaceuticals in the women's health division for Cook Medical in Spencer from 2007 until 2020.

She is survived by her sisters, Nancy (Fred) Grabner of Bloomington and Janet Williamson of Carmel, her brother, Shawn Woodward of Carmel; and several nieces and nephews.
