Lillian Ellen Guthrie, 98, of Henderson, Nevada passed away August 11, 2015, at Prestige Health and Living in Henderson, Nevada. She was born April 17, 1917, in Marion, Indiana to James J. and Maude G. (Nail) McGrew, the fifth of 18 children.
