



## Lou Anna Burch

March 19, 1930 - October 15, 2016

Lou Anna Burch, 86, long-time resident of Bloomington, IN and current resident of Garner, NC, returned home to her Heavenly Father Saturday, October 15, 2016. After battling a serious blood and lung infection, Lou Anna passed away on Saturday at Johnston UNC Hospital in Clayton, NC.

Lou Anna was born on March 19, 1930 in Lyons, IN, the daughter of Floyd Oral ("Slick") and Eva Marie Hubbard. She was united in Marriage to her sweetheart, Donald W. Burch, on December 31, 1950, in Lyons, IN. He preceded her in death on December 11, 2012. They were married for 62 blissful years.
