Louisa Deckard, of Bloomington, IN, died Monday, January 6, 2020, at 103 years of age. Louisa was born November 16, 1916, on the Posey county farm home of her parents, Clyde and Nellie (Vaught) Montgomery. She graduated from Cynthiana High school in 1934 where she received an Honor Certificate for best grades. Continuing her education at Indiana University she graduated in 1938 with a BA degree in Latin, and English. She then started her first formal teaching position in the Cynthiana High school, continuing in later years at North Posey Jr/Sr High. She met Ernest (Pat) Deckard while at Bloomington. They married January 18, 1941, in Posey County.

Louisa is survived by her four children, Carolyn Price, of Norris City, IL, Edward (Brenda) Deckard, of Fargo, ND, James (Pat) Deckard, of Mayfield, KY, and Lisa (William) Southern, of Bloomington, IN; sister, Pearl Ellen McIntyre, of Evansville, IN, sister-in-law, Katherine Montgomery, of Logansport, IN, 9 grandchildren, 14 great grandchildren, and 3 great-great grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents, stepfather, Cort, husband, an infant son, brother, Thomas, brother-in-law, Richard, grandson, Christopher, and son-in-law, Dan Price.

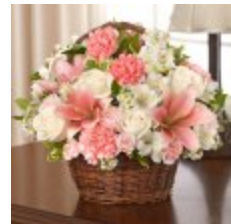
