Lucille Ritter Hedrick of Bloomington passed away on September 30, 2024. She had family at her side, at Richland Bean Blossom Health Care Center.

She was born on August 30, 1928 in rural Lawrence County. She was the eighth of nine children born to Otto and Oma (Sowers) Ritter. She attended grade school at Donica and Heltonville Schools and graduated from Needmore High School in 1945.

Following graduation she worked at RCA in Bloomington. She met Roger Lee Hedrick while roller skating at the Airport Roller Rink. They were married in Bloomington on February 14, 1948. They were married for almost 54 years until his death on February 3, 2002.

She was employed as a secretary-bookkeeper and retired in 1986, after 25 years of service with South Indiana Conference of the United Methodist Church.

assistant secretary, taught Sunday School in the children's department, served on the Eucharist

Team, and was active in the United Methodist Women.
