M. Phil Hathaway, of Bloomington, died June 21, 2016 in the Meadowood Health Pavilion. Born November 23, 1929 in South Whitley, IN, he was the son of the late Carper and Blanche (Harshman) Hathaway.

Phil was a Certified Public Accountant and had a career in both public practice and industry. He was a past Treasurer of Cook Group Inc.

He was a graduate of Purdue University, but supported Indiana University for many years.

He belonged to the Rotary Club for 55 years and was a member of many other service and professional organizations. He was a member of the First Christian Church of Bloomington, where he served as Deacon, Elder and Moderator. He was also Treasurer of the church for many years.

Phil is survived by his wife, Margaret (Smith) Hathaway, with whom he shared over 62 great years.
