



## Margaret O'Neal Tomey

November 13, 1920 - October 26, 2012

Margaret O'Neal Tomey was born on November 13, 1920 and raised on farm in Martin County, Indiana. She idolized her parents, Thomas Bernard and Rose Isabell (Lannan) O'Neal and spoke often of her father. She spent time teaching in California and Hawaii where among other things; she was Bette Midler's Latin teacher. She was the Principal of a private school in New York and then moved back to California. In the late 1970's she moved to Bloomington to marry George Tomey. In only a couple of years, George died. Margaret worked as an abstracter for Jim Thompson until he retired and would be seen regularly at the Court House. Margaret became very active in Republican politics in the early 1980's. She was a Precinct Committeeman and the Republican member of the Board of Voter Registration. She spent tireless hours helping candidates with mailings, proof reading election materials, training poll workers and anything she could to make sure elections went smoothly.

Margaret's energy was reflected in her scowl when something concerned her or her beautiful smile when she was glad to see you. She could be seen almost every day driving through town in her 1965 Light green Volkswagen and you had better watch

out because she wasn't afraid of anything.

When Margaret wasn't working or volunteering, she was traveling. At least twice each year she would take a trip - Antarctica, camping in the Peruvian rain forests, a Russian freighter to the North Pole, Cuba, every continent, and every place imaginable - her favorite was Ireland. Many trips were with Doctors Without Borders.

Margaret died peacefully at her home on Friday, October 26, 2012, 91 years of age. She was extremely kind and generous person. She will be missed by those who loved her.

Graveside services will be 1:00 pm Tuesday, October 30, 2012 at Rose Hill Cemetery. A Memorial service will be held at a later date. In lieu of flowers, please make contributions to Sister's of Providence at St. Mary's of the Woods in Margaret's name.
