



## Margaret "Peggy" Louise Fowler

November 16, 1918 - April 14, 2021

Margaret (Peggy) Louise Fowler passed away at Bell Trace Senior Living Center in Bloomington, Indiana on Wednesday, April 14, 2021. She was 102 years old.

Peggy was born November 16, 1918, in Monroe County, one of seven children to Daniel and Gladys Greene. She lived nearly her entire life in Harrodsburg, Indiana, only moving to Bloomington in her 90's to live with her sister Pat. A few years later, Peggy and Pat moved together to Bell Trace Senior Living Center.

Peggy graduated from Smithville High School where she met her future husband, John (Bob) Robert Fowler. They were married 67 years before his death in 2008. She worked at Nurre Mirror Plate Company and Fountain Federal Savings and Loan before retiring in 1976 to care for her grandchildren.
