



Marianne "Vicky" Felton

August 20, 1939 - October 7, 2023

Marianne "Vicky" Felton, 94, died of natural causes on October 7, 2023, at Baylor Scott & White Hospital in Lakeway, TX. She was born in Berlin, Germany on August 20, 1929, the daughter of Curt and Gertrude Victorius. Marianne and her mother left Germany in 1939, just before the borders closed. They met up with her father and older brother in the U.S. and settled in North Carolina, where Curt became a professor of economics at Guilford College.

Marianne met her husband, Don Felton while she was a travelling economist in South Korea and they were married in Japan in May of 1958. They had 2 children Kenny (1959) and Cindy (1960) and she raised them, with her husband, while continuing her studies. Marianne received her Ph.D. in Economics in 1979 and became a professor of economics at Indiana University Southeast shortly afterward.

Marianne was passionate about classical music, especially opera, and ballet. She loved to watch tennis, Olympic figure skating and gymnastics.

Marianne was predeceased by her parents Curt and Gertrude Victorius, her husband Don and her brother Claus Victorius. She is survived by her children Kenny and Cindy, her granddaughter and three great-granddaughters.
